

The Privacy Policy on this page

Interested Parties: Visitors of the Website

In compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter the “Regulation”) and Law No. 171, 21/12/2018, of the Republic of San Marino, this page describes how the personal data of the visitors of the website at www.weddingsitaly.com are processed.

This information does not apply to other websites, pages or online services reachable via any links published on the sites but referring to resources external to the Data Controller’s domain.

This page contains information on how the personal details of the users of this website are managed. The Privacy Policy, in compliance with article 13 of the Regulation (EU) and Law No. 171, 21/12/2018, of the Republic of San Marino on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data, applies to those who interact with the *web* services offered by “**REGENCY SAN MARINO S.R.L.**”, via email at amministrazione@weddingsitaly.it. Data Controller

When accessing this website, data referring to identifiable or non-identifiable persons may be processed.

The Data Controller is “**REGENCY SAN MARINO S.R.L.**”, with registered and operational offices in Via Cipriano Manetti, 34 – 47891 Dogana (RSM), COE: SM 05557 in the person of its *pro tempore* legal representative.

The personal data mentioned on this page are processed by “**REGENCY SAN MARINO S.R.L.**” to carry out its activities. Depending on the different purposes for which the data are collected, consent, contract execution, compliance with an obligation and achievement of a legitimate interest are the legal basis of the processing.

Data Processing Location

The processing connected with the *online* services offered by this website is carried out in *Italy* and is managed by the provider of *earthlink.net* and handled by the technical staff of *Enrico Giacomelli*’s team and others appointed by “**REGENCY SAN MARINO S.R.L.**”, for updating and maintenance purposes. No data relevant to the *web* service is divulged to third parties. Personal data voluntarily provided by users who send contact requests are used only to provide the service or comply with the specific request, including with the assistance of external service providers.

Type of Data Processed and Purposes

Browsing Data

The information technology systems and software procedures used by this website during the course of its normal operation acquire some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This category of data includes: IP addresses, domain names of the computers used by users to connect to the site; the addresses in URI/URL (Uniform Resource Identifier/Locator) format of the resources requested, the time when the request is made, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters concerning the user’s operating system and computer environment.

These data, necessary to obtain the web service, are also processed for the following purposes:

- Obtain statistical information on the use of the services (most viewed pages, number of visitors per time range or per day, user geographical origin, etc.);
- Ensure the services provided work smoothly.

Data provided by users

By optionally, voluntarily and explicitly sending messages to “**REGENCY SAN MARINO S.R.L.**”, or filling in and submitting the forms available on the website www.weddingsitaly.com, the receiver automatically acquires the user’s contact details, required to reply to their requests, and any other personal data included in the communications.

Specific privacy policies will be published on the pages of the website www.weddingsitaly.com dedicated to the provision of certain services.

Cookies and other tracking systems

Profiling cookies are not used.

Session cookies (non-persistent) are used for purposes strictly limited to guaranteeing the safe and efficient browsing of the websites. Users can manage the use of session cookies stored by their terminals or browsers – for different retention periods depending on the third-party service provider – at the end of HTTP sessions in the service logs. The data that may be acquired using cookies and the processing methods used are described in detail in the Cookie Policy.

Optional Data

Aside from what specified for browsing data, the provision of the personal data in the “**REGENCY SAN MARINO S.R.L.**” information request forms are optional. Whenever said data is requested, a specific privacy policy will be provided and, if necessary, users will be asked to provide their consent.

Data Processing Methods

Personal data are processed with automated systems only for the period of time necessary to fulfil the purposes for which they were collected. Specific security measures are in place to prevent loss, unlawful and inappropriate use of data and unauthorised access. Please note that links to third-party websites managed by other data controllers are provided to offer a comprehensive service. We decline any responsibility for errors, content, cookies, unlawful immoral content, advertising, banners or files that violate any laws or privacy regulations published on websites not managed by us to which we make reference.

Data Recipients

The above-mentioned data collected by the website will be accessible to the following subjects appointed by “**REGENCY SAN MARINO S.R.L.**”, in compliance with article 28 of the Regulation and article 29 of Law No. 171, 21/12/2018, of the Republic of San Marino, in their capacity as Data Processors.

Personal data are also processed by “**REGENCY SAN MARINO S.R.L.**” personnel, acting under specific instructions regarding the processing purposes and methods.

Data Transfer Abroad

The Data Controller is assisted by data processors located in non-EU countries, specifically: California, with the guarantee of the adoption of measures such as standard contractual Clauses, in the case of the USA the EU-US Privacy Shield agreement, or with the consent of the Data Subjects.

Data Subject Rights

You have the right to request the Data Controller to erase (right to be forgotten), limit the use, update, rectify your data, request their portability or object to their processing, and exercise all the rights recognised by articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 of the GDPR and Law No. 171, 21/12/2018, of the Republic of San Marino, if applicable to the data processing purposes.

Regulation (EU) 2016/679 and Law No. 171, 21/12/2018, of the Republic of San Marino: Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23

1. The Data Subject shall have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning them exist, regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form.

2. The Data Subject shall have the right to be informed of:
 - a. the source of the personal data;
 - b. the purposes and methods of the processing;
 - c. the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out with the help of electronic means;
 - d. the identification data concerning Data Controller, Data Processors and the Designated Representative as per article 5, comma 2;
 - e. the entities or categories of entity to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may get to know said data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing.

3. The Data Subject shall have the right to obtain the:
 - a. update, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data;
 - b. erasure, anonymization or blocking of data that has been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which it has been collected or subsequently processed;
 - c. certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected;
 - d. portability of the data.

4. The Data Subject shall have the right to object, in whole or in part:
 - a. on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning them, even though it is relevant to the purpose of the collection;
 - b. to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys.

Right to Complain

Data subjects who believe that the processing of their personal data conducted through this site violates the GDPR and national legislation provisions have the right to submit a complaint to the Data Protection Authority, as provided by article 77 of the Regulation, or take legal action (article 79 of the Regulation) and articles 66, 67, 70 of Law No. 171, 21/12/2018, of the Republic of San Marino.
